In light of the global Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, on March 15, 2020, the Michigan Supreme Court issued an [administrative order](#) authorizing trial courts to implement emergency measures to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus and protect court officers and visitors. As a result, many courts have limited in-person access to courthouses or shut down all but essential operations. Courts and judges are changing their practices and procedures on a daily basis to provide some access to courts in the event of emergency and other time sensitive matters (e.g. criminal matters with a person in custody). Bodman's litigation team is monitoring all court closures and will continue to make every effort to ensure our client's interests are well-represented in this difficult time.
